TBBingo Premium HD 1920x1080p Help Document

Once the software is installed follow instructions below to set up dual screen for Windows 10 (other versions will be similar)

If setup correctly the bingo software will appear on both screens, main caller screen and then secondary screen for players.

To change the game pattern on the 75 number version, double click the game pattern panel to change pattern.

You can also create your own by copying and editing the base.png file.

Step 1: Check Hardware Compatibility

Make sure your computer supports dual monitors and that you have the necessary hardware connections (e.g., HDMI, DisplayPort, VGA) available on your computer and monitors.

Step 2: Connect the Monitors

Connect one end of the cable (HDMI, DisplayPort, VGA) to the appropriate port on your computer and the other end to the corresponding port on the first monitor. Repeat this process to connect the second monitor.

Step 3: Configure Display Settings

- 1. Right-click on an empty area on your desktop and select "Display settings" from the context menu.
- 2. The "Settings" page will open. Scroll down to the "Multiple displays" section.
- 3. Make sure that the "Extend these displays" option is selected. If not, select it from the drop-down menu.
- 4. You will see two monitors represented on the screen. Select the monitor you want to adjust and make sure it is marked as "Extend desktop to this display."
- 5. Arrange the monitors by dragging and dropping them in the correct position according to their physical arrangement on your desk. This helps align the displays correctly.
- 6. Select the first monitor, and in the "Resolution" drop-down menu, choose "1920x1080". Set the scaling to "100%." This ensures that the content on both monitors appears at the same size.
- 7. Repeat steps 6 and 7 for the second monitor.
- 8. Click "Apply" to save the changes. Your desktop should now extend across both monitors with a resolution of 1920x1080 and 100% scaling.

Step 4: Customize Display Settings (Optional) You can further customize your dual-monitor setup by adjusting additional display settings:

- Change the primary monitor: If you want one monitor to be your main display, go to "Display settings," select the monitor you want to set as the primary, and check the box that says "Make this my main display."
- Adjust individual monitor settings: Right-click on the desktop, select "Display settings," and click on the monitor you want to customize. You can then adjust settings such as brightness, contrast, and colour calibration specific to that monitor.
